# STAGES OF A KNIGHT CONTINUED


#### \* SQUIRE (AGE 12-13)

## STAGES OF A KNIGHT CONTINUED

- KNIGHT (WHEN QUALIFIED)
  - USUALLY KNIGHTED BY THE KING
